



Early work continuing on Tumbi Road and Central Coast Highway intersection upgrade

May 2023

The Australian and NSW governments are planning to improve traffic flow and safety by upgrading the Central Coast Highway for 3.8 kilometres between Wamberal and Bateau Bay. As part of the project, the upgrade of the most congested intersection at Central Coast Highway and Tumbi Road has been prioritised and fast tracked.

Transport for NSW will continue to carry out early work in preparation for the Central Coast Highway and Tumbi Road intersection upgrade.

Early work will continue on the Central Coast Highway from Ulamba Avenue to just north of the Pacific Gardens Hotel and includes installing utilities, earthworks, trenching and excavation.

Work will take place between **7am** to **5pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays** and is expected to be completed by **late June 2023**, weather permitting.

You will be notified of any work planned outside of these hours.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates noise and light. We will make every effort to minimise noise by staging the work at different locations and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

To ensure the work zone is safe existing traffic changes will remain in place. On the Central Coast Highway, 50 metres north of the Pacific Garden Hotel to the Wamberal fruit shop, this includes:

- closure of southbound shoulder and overtaking lane
- no right hand turn into the Pacific Garden Hotel from the southbound lane, detour via the roundabout at Tumbi Road intersection
- barriers

Traffic control and a 40km/h speed limit through the work site will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times.


