

Turrella Station Upgrade

Community notification – February 2023

Transport for NSW is upgrading Turrella Station as part of the Transport Access Program (TAP) to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

Activities planned for February at Turrella Station will include:

- installation of the lift shaft walls
- overhead wiring foundation installation
- platform and station building works
- placement of new stairs and canopy structural steel
- installation of canopy glazed panels
- installation of transformer pad
- electrical works and water removal activities
- delivery of construction material and equipment
- the above works involve piling, excavating, concreting and the use of a crane.

Out of hours work

We will be working at Turrella Station **from 12.45am Saturday 18 February to 10pm Sunday 19 February** during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork period when trains are not running. There will be no access to Turrella Station during out of hours work. Construction access to the rail corridor will be via Henderson Street. Schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather and site conditions.

What to expect

- partial road closure will be in place on Henderson Street and Reede Street bridge to enable the set-up of equipment to carry out works on the platform
- 6 parking spaces will be temporarily removed **from 4pm Friday 17 February until 10pm Sunday 19 February** on Henderson Street
- see map overleaf for road closure and parking removal details. Drivers are asked to follow the direction of traffic control and signage.



Temporary lane closures on Reede Street bridge

We will continue to intermittently close one lane of Reede Street bridge until October 2023. These closures are required to enable the set-up of equipment to carry out works on the station platform below.

Vehicle and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times under traffic management. Drivers will be escorted via pilot vehicle. Follow traffic signage and allow for additional travel times during this period.

Standard construction hours

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm Saturdays**. We thank you for your patience as we carry out this important work.
