Turrella Station Upgrade

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal and Bidjigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

The Turrella Station Upgrade is delivered as part of the Transport Access Program.

The upgrade will provide a station precinct that is accessible to people with a disability, limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

What are we doing in June?

- installation of pre-cast concourse landing, new lift shaft and roofing, using a crane set up on Turrella Street
- station platform works including continuing installation of canopy glazing, stair handrails, mesh screens, cabling and containment for new electrical and public address systems and platform drainage installation
- station building upgrades to new unisex toilets
- road and footpath work including upgrade to the northern footpath on Reede and Turrella streets.

The above works involve delivery and removal of construction material and equipment, as well as the use of heavy equipment such as cranes, concrete pumps, excavators and a hi-rail plant.

When we'll be working

Our construction hours will be between **7am and 6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

Out of hours work

Mobilisation and set-up activities for crane lifting work will commence from **10pm Friday 23 June**. A Sydney Trains trackwork period will take place between **2am Saturday 24 June and 2am Monday 26 June**, and the station will be closed with buses replacing trains.

Access to track will be via Bardwell Park. Traffic control will provide guidance to drivers in this location. Demobilisation and clean-up activities at Turrella Station will be undertaken from **2am to 7am Monday 26 June**. During these works, Turrella and Reede streets will be partially closed to traffic. See map over page. Impacted residents will be contacted individually.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- traffic controllers and signage
- lane closures and reduced speed limits
- footpath closures
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Temporary lane closures on Reede Street bridge

We will continue to intermittently close one lane of Reede Street bridge during the day until October 2023. These closures are required to enable the set-up of equipment and to carry out works on the station platform.

Vehicle and pedestrian access will be maintained at all times under traffic management. Follow traffic signage and allow for additional travel times during this period.

Changes to night work program

Earlier this month, the community was informed of planned extended night works from **6pm Monday 29 May to 7am Friday 2 June**. These works will occur during a planned Sydney Trains trackwork period when the station is closed and trains will not be running. Buses will be replacing trains. Impacted residents will be contacted individually. For the duration of these works access and use of the site compound at 127-135 Turrella Street will be required.
