Commemorating the 2022 UCI route – Stage One

Riding the blue line

In September 2022, Wollongong hosted the UCI Road World Championships—one of the world's top five annual sporting events—with over 670 cyclists from 73 countries participating. To commemorate the event, Transport for NSW will be painting blue line markings along the history-making route from Helensburgh to North Wollongong. This will give experienced riders the opportunity to take in the stunning surrounds of the Illawarra, with some diversions in place to ensure the safety of riders and motorists.

What will this work mean for you?

We will be delivering this work in two stages -

- Stage One is between Walker Street at Cowper Lane, Helensburgh and Lawrence Hargrave Drive at Wrexham Road, Thirroul.
- The next stages will be between Lawrence Hargrave Drive at Wrexham Road, finishing at Marine Drive (Lang Park), North Wollongong.


Work will be carried out at night to lessen the impact on the road network. During work hours, there will be no onstreet parking and temporary lane closures will be in place for the safety of workers and motorists. There will be no impacts to parking, residents, or businesses after the installation. Nearby residents and businesses will be notified ahead of any work.

We are working closely with Wollongong City Council to plan for the next stages. More details including the timing of installation will be provided to the community when available.
