


St Peters Station Upgrade Community Update

Transport Access Program

May 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Gadigal and Wangal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

What work are we doing in May?

Work includes:

- Landscaping on Railway Lane and Lord Street including line marking work
- Installing lifts including cladding, glazing and louvre
- Relocating the opal card reader
- Installing platform furniture and canopies
- Installation and testing of CCTV
- · Installation of signage and wayfinding
- Installing handrails and platform tactiles
- Installing screens on footbridge and lifts.

When and where we'll be working

In May, work at the station will continue **Monday to**Friday from 7am until 6pm, and from 8am until 1pm on

Saturdays.

Out of hours works

Some activities are required to be undertaken outside of our standard work hours. These activities have been planned during some scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork weekends as follows:

- From 6am until 6pm Saturday 6 and Sunday 7 May
- From 4am Saturday 13 until 10pm Sunday 14 May
- From 4am Saturday 20 until 10pm Sunday 21 May

We will also be doing additional night works on the following days:

• Tuesday 2 May 12am until 5am on Lord Street

From 6pm Tuesday 9 May until 6am Wednesday
 10 May within the rail corridor.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Intermittent periods of high noise
- A generator used at night within the rail corridor continuously from Monday 8 May to Sunday 21 May
- Increase in construction traffic
- Temporary parking restrictions: at times, up to eight spaces on Lord Street will be temporarily unavailable to allow for landscaping works to be carried out
- Temporary closure of Lord Street between King and John Streets from 12am until 5am Tuesday 2 May to allow for line marking to take place. Detour is via King, Wells and Johns Streets
- Temporary closure of station facilities: the Station Master's office and the existing station toilets are currently closed due to investigation works.

Changes to scheduled works

Work schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather, and site conditions. Further notification will be provided should there be a significant change to the construction program.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:



- Reducing our noise as much as possible
- The use of noise blankets where possible, replacing reversing beepers with clickers
- Traffic control and signage
- Directional lighting pointed away from residential properties wherever possible.
