



Flood repair on Oxley Highway near Warren from Thursday 1 June

May 2023

Transport for NSW is carrying out essential pavement repair work at two locations on the Oxley Highway north of Warren from Thursday 1 June.

What work are we doing?

The work will include excavation and removal of existing pavement and replacement of damaged road surfaces at:

- Tiger Bay Causeway, 1.8km north of Warren
- Ewenmar Causeway, 3km north of Warren

When and where we'll be working

We will be working seven days a week between **7am** and **6pm**.

We expect to complete the work in **five weeks**, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

We will be working from 1.8km north of Warren, for 4km travelling towards Gilgandra.

We have included a map to show the area of the work.

What will this mean for you?

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times.

A 60km/h speed limit will be in place outside work hours.

Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

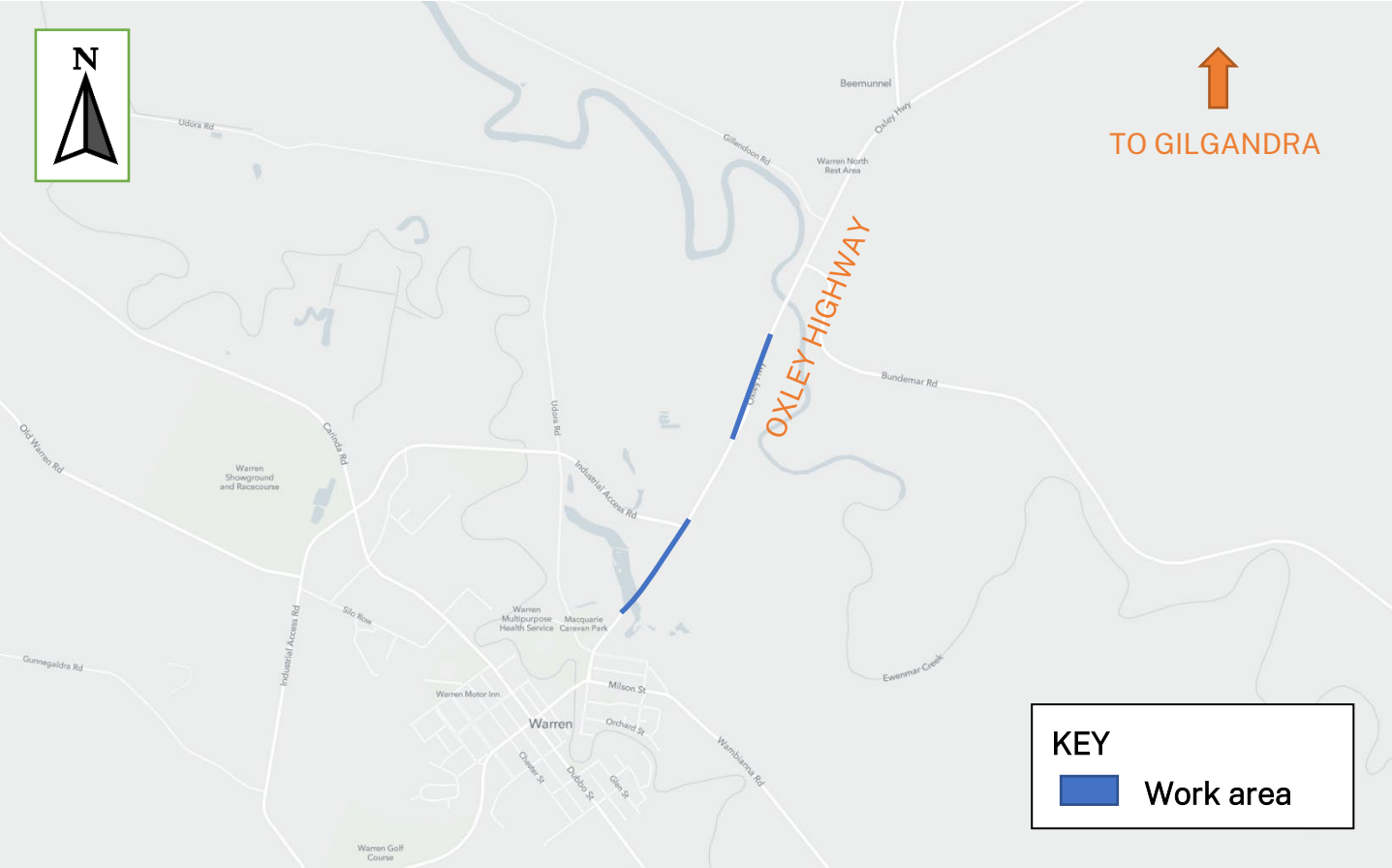
