



Waitara Station Upgrade

Transport Access Program

July 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the people of the Darug and Guringai Nations as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Waitara Station as part of the Transport Access Program (TAP) to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

What work are we doing in July?

Work planned for July:

- continuing concrete works on the Alexandria Parade entrance walls and forecourt
- commencing concrete works for the new Alexandria Parade pedestrian crossing (on the rail side of the street)
- continuing architectural finishes within the new underpass and new station staircases
- continuing electrical and security system upgrade work within the new underpass, new stairs and around the station precinct.
- continuing construction of the platform canopy structural steel segments within the commuter car park
- commencing excavation within the commuter car park for new underground services including power and telecommunications.

We will be working at the station and the site compounds at Romsey Street and Alexandria Parade.

When we'll be working

Working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturday**. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

What will this mean for you?

We will be using a range of equipment including mobile cranes, forklifts, excavators, concrete trucks and pumps, vacuum trucks, delivery trucks, power tools and hand tools.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment. This includes:

- traffic control and signage in place
- fencing for safety and security
- reducing our noise as much as possible by turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

New Alexandria Parade pedestrian crossing

From **7am Monday 10 July**, we will start work to build a new raised pedestrian crossing on Alexandria Parade, south-east of the Orara Street intersection. The new crossing will link to the station underpass, stairs and lifts currently under construction.

The crossing will be built in stages to minimise our impact to the community. This work is expected to take **three months** to complete, weather permitting.

The first stage of work during July will be on the rail corridor side of Alexandria Parade with no impact expected to pedestrians or traffic flow. Directional signage will be in place.
