

# Waitara Station Upgrade

### **Transport Access Program**

April 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the people of the Darug and Guringai Nations as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Waitara Station as part of the Transport Access Program (TAP) to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

#### Work progress

Work at the station is progressing well. During March, the remaining section of the underpass was fully excavated. This underpass will provide pedestrian access to the new station entrance off Alexandria Parade and the Waitara Avenue commuter car park.

Other work completed in March included the concrete work for the lift on the Waitara Avenue car park side and work on the new platform stairs.

#### What work are we doing?

Work planned for April includes:

- continuing the installation of formwork, tying reinforcement and pouring concrete for the island platform lift shaft
- continuing concrete works on the new forecourt area within the Alexandria Parade car park
- concrete works within the new station underpass
- delivery and fit out of lift shaft toppings
- station services upgrade works including the toilet upgrade and drainage works
- electrical upgrade work within the new underpass, new stairs and around the station precinct

• Minor tree trimming and removal, subject to approval.

We'll be working at the station and the site compound at Romsey Street.

#### When we'll be working

Working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturday.** We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

#### What will this mean for you?

We will be using a range of equipment throughout April, including mobile cranes, forklifts, excavators, concrete trucks and pumps, vacuum trucks, delivery, power tools and hand tools.

#### Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- traffic control and signage in place for changes to access and parking
- fencing for safety and security
- reducing our noise as much as possible by turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

## Station toilets closed – temporary toilets available

The station toilets are temporarily closed to allow the facilities to be upgraded. Temporary toilets are available for use at the Hornsby end of the station building (on the platform) and will be open during the station's staffed hours from **6am to 12:30pm** Monday to Friday. Signage is in place to help customers with these temporary changes.

### Temporary access, parking and traffic changes

Throughout our upgrade work, there may be temporary access and traffic changes on Alexandria Parade and Waitara Avenue commuter car park. This may require temporary single lane road closures and/or parking removal to accommodate large vehicles carrying out construction work.
