



# Waitara Station Upgrade

## Transport Access Program

June 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges the people of the Darug and Guringai Nations as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is upgrading Waitara Station as part of the Transport Access Program (TAP) to make it easier for everyone to access, including people with a disability or limited mobility, parents/carers with prams and customers with luggage.

### What work are we doing in June?

Work planned for June includes:

- starting the installation of formwork, tying reinforcement and pouring concrete for the underpass entrance walls on Alexandria Parade
- starting architectural finishes within the new underpass and new station staircases
- installing the new steel canopy on the western (car park area) forecourt
- starting construction of the new Alexandria Parade pedestrian crossing
- continuing electrical and security system upgrade work within the new underpass, new stairs and around the station precinct.

We will be working at the station and the site compounds at Romsey Street and Alexandria Parade.

### When we'll be working

Working hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturday**. We will notify nearby residents and businesses in advance if we need to work outside these times.

### What will this mean for you?

We will be using a range of equipment including mobile cranes, forklifts, excavators, concrete trucks

and pumps, vacuum trucks, delivery trucks, power tools and hand tools.

### Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- traffic control and signage in place for changes to access and parking
- fencing for safety and security
- reducing our noise as much as possible by turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers.

### Weekend work – Saturday 3 June

Weekend work will be carried out from **4am to 2pm on Saturday 3 June**. Our weekend work will involve the use of trucks and a mobile crane to deliver bulky materials. Signage will be in place.

### Night work – 19 to 22 June

Night work will be carried out from **Monday 19 June until Thursday 22 June from 12am to 6am**. Trains are not operating at this time and the station will be closed. Our night work will involve the use of a mobile crane to install a new canopy within the station car park and remove some plant and materials from the island platform. Equipment we will use includes a crane, small excavator and truck, mobile lighting, power and hand tools.

## Temporary removal of parking spaces in the Commuter Car Park

To facilitate safe construction, please note the following changes to the commuter car park.

From **Friday 2 June 2023** to enable the safe fabrication of the new car park canopy, **up to 10 parking spaces will be temporarily removed** within the Waitara Avenue commuter car park to allow the project team to assemble the canopy and lift into place using a mobile crane without disruptions to train services. The work is expected to take four weeks to complete, weather permitting.

### Weekend work Saturday 3 June

Sections of the commuter car park will be **closed on Saturday 3 June between 4am and 2pm** during the planned weekend work.

### Night work Monday 19 to Thursday 22 June

The commuter car park will be **closed between 12am to 6am** from **Monday 19 June until Thursday 22 June** while we undertake night work when trains aren't running.
