

Waterfall Enabling Work Project Construction update April 2020

Notification of enabling work during April

Work is continuing to prepare for major construction activities commencing mid-year which will enable longer trains to stop at Waterfall and improve the way freight and passenger services travel through the rail network in the future.

Work underway at Waterfall

Abergeldie are carrying out the enabling work including the relocation of utility services and construction of retaining walls. During April, the following activities will take place:

- earthwork and piling work for construction of retaining walls in the rail corridor
- civil excavations for the relocation of utilities.

Day work

All work activities, where possible, will be undertaken during the following hours:

- 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday
- 8am to 1pm Saturday. No work on Sundays or public holidays.

Night work

During April, night work will take place outside of construction hours to ensure the safety of workers, pedestrians and motorists, and to minimise impacts to traffic. Please note this is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change. Night work will take place on the following dates:

• Tuesday 31 March (6-10pm), Wednesday 1 and Thursday 2 April (6pm-7am)

This is required for the following activities:

- deliveries of large materials and plant
- excavations for the installation of utilities along the Princes Highway
- removal of guard rails and installation of traffic barriers.

Temporary speed reduction will be in place during night work on the Princes Highway between Bundarra Street and Eckersley Road from 80 km/h to 40 km/h.

Traffic control will be in place during this time. Every effort will be made to reduce noise impacts during this work.

We will keep the community informed on upcoming night work, providing seven days' notice prior to the start of night work in the area.
