

Waterfall Enabling Work Project Changes to night work program April 2020

The safety of our project team and the community is our top priority. Currently, project work is continuing on site in accordance with the current government policies regarding COVID-19 and mitigation measures, including safe working practices, have been implemented.

Changes to our night work program during April

Thank you to the community for providing feedback on the changes to the night work program during April 2020. Based on your feedback residents agreed to the change from the current schedule (Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursdays) to one week of five consecutive nights of work.

This change in the night work program allows the project team to reduce the total number of nights worked in your area, to minimise the disruption period for residents, businesses and road users.

Updated night work program

We will be working five consecutive nights from 6pm to 7am on **Tuesday 14 April to Saturday 18 April**, subject to weather and site conditions.

What to expect

Night work activities will include:

- deliveries of large materials and plant
- excavations for the installation of utilities along the Princes Highway
- installation of traffic barriers.

Temporary speed reduction will be in place during night work on the Princes Highway between Bundarra Street and Eckersley Road from 80 km/h to 40 km/h. Traffic control will be in place during this time.

Equipment being used

This will include trucks, excavators, flood lights, powered hand tools and compaction equipment.

Mitigation measures

Some of the work will be noisy and we try to reduce the noise when we can. Some ways we do this include:

- conduct noisy work early in the early evening when possible
- use squawkers rather than beepers on vehicles
- only using noisy machinery when we absolutely have to
- direct the noise and lights away from residents when we can.
