

# Waterfall Stabling Yard and Platform Extension Project

## Planning approval granted for Waterfall Stabling Yard and Platform Extension Project

As part of the More Trains, More Services program, the works at Waterfall will increase the number of train services along the line, allowing longer trains to stop at Waterfall and improve the way freight and passenger services travel through the rail network.

Modifications near Waterfall Station are required to improve passenger services on the South Coast Line.

The Project includes:

- a new stabling yard for additional trains and rail works within the corridor
- platform extension to cater for 10-car New Intercity Fleet trains
- a new staff amenities building
- new tracks for stabling of ten 8-carriage trains.

## Feedback from the community

A Review of Environmental Factors was prepared and community feedback invited from 23 August to 6 September 2019. We would like to thank the community for their feedback, which will help further develop the project.

## Next steps

The early works construction contract has been awarded to Abergeldie Contractors Pty Ltd and the project is scheduled to start **Monday 13 January 2020**.

During January, subject to approval the project team will undertake the following activities:

- site establishment
- geotechnical and survey works

- vegetation removal
- utilities works
- earth works.

To enable this work there will be some night work to allow for deliveries to be made to site in order to maintain safety of motorists and Project staff.

Every effort would be made to minimise any construction impacts to the local community. We will keep the community and customers informed prior to any activities taking place.

## Construction timeline

Construction is expected to start Monday 13 January 2020 and take approximately six months to complete. The main construction works will commence mid-2020 and we will keep the community updated once a contractor is appointed.
