

Waterfall Stabling Yard and Platform Extension Project

Project update | **May 2022**

As part of the More Trains, More Services program, we are upgrading Waterfall Station, the stabling yard and associated rail corridor infrastructure to accommodate the Mariyung fleet.

What's next at Waterfall?

In May, our main activities will include:

- installation of bridge support columns and supporting infrastructure for the new staff footbridge requiring a temporary, single-lane closure of the Princes Highway overnight. Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists with these changes.
- construction of new track and removal of old track which will include tamping machines and use of vibratory rollers
- installing new overhead wiring and signalling equipment, new drainage and cable route installation
- installation of a prefabricated signalling facility, requiring a temporary, single-lane closure of the Princes Highway overnight. Traffic control

will be in place to assist motorists with these changes.

- electrical upgrade work at the Heathcote Rail Substation involving trenching work, vacuum trucks, a crane, and temporary traffic changes.

Upcoming night work

In May, some activities are required to take place outside of standard construction hours.

This work has been scheduled to take place during Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains are running, minimising disruptions to commuter services and improving the safety of our construction team and customers.

Night work will be carried out between:

- **6pm Friday 29 April and 7am Monday 2 May** (Heathcote Rail Substation)
- **6pm Friday 6 May and 7am Monday 9 May** (Heathcote Rail Substation & Waterfall Station)

- **6pm Friday 13 and 7am Monday 16 May**
(Waterfall Station)
- **6pm Friday 20 and 7am Monday 23 May**
(Waterfall Station).

From late April until 31 July, some deliveries will take place outside of standard construction hours however this work is not expected to impact the community.

Temporary changes to commuter car parking and traffic movements

To support construction activities at Waterfall we require temporary use of approximately 30 commuter car spaces from **11pm Tuesday 17 until 6pm Wednesday 25 May**.

We will also require an additional 20 spaces from **6pm Friday 20 until 5am Monday 23 May**.



In May, we are also planning to complete the installation of an Ausgrid pole mounted transformer on the northern side of the Princes Highway, opposite Hanrob Pet Hotels. To safely facilitate the overhead wiring work, we will be temporarily closing lanes on the Princes Highway. Traffic control will be in place to assist motorists with these changes.

Bridge installation and closure of south-bound lanes on Pacific Highway

In our last monthly notification, we advised that the staff footbridge would be installed during the weekend of 21-22 May. Due to unforeseen circumstances, this work has been moved to the weekend of 2-3 July.

In July, we will be installing the main body of the staff footbridge. This work will require closure of both south-bound lanes on the Princes Highway so a 400-tonne crane can safely lift in bridge segments. Traffic will be diverted to the northbound lanes which will operate as contraflow lanes, enabling both north and southbound lane traffic to move across a 1.6km stretch of highway. To safely facilitate traffic movements, we are also planning to restrict parking in local streets over one weekend.

In the coming months, we will be distributing more information about this work and visiting residents to discuss planned activities in more detail.
