

Night work during February

Further to our monthly notification, the Waterfall Enabling Project team will conduct night work to safely carry out construction activities and deliveries and complete the site compound establishment. The site compound is located next to Princes Highway, Waterfall, approximately 1.3 km north of Waterfall station (refer to map overleaf).

Due to the proximity of the site to the Princes Highway these works will be carried out at night (subject to weather and site conditions) during the following dates:

- **Wednesday 19 February to Thursday 20 February from 6pm to 7am**
- **Wednesday 26 February to Thursday 27 February from 6pm to 7am**
- **Wednesday 4 March to Thursday 5 March from 6pm to 7am**

This work will involve:

- delivery of large machinery and materials
- installation of traffic barriers and vegetation clearing along Princes Highway from the works compound down to the truck stopping bay
- temporary speed reduction on the Princes Highway between Bundarra Street and Eckersley Road please adhere to speed restrictions as per road signage.

Traffic control will be in place during this time. Every effort will be made to reduce noise impacts during this work.
