Further to our monthly notification, the Waterfall Enabling Project team will undertake night work to install traffic barriers and construct a temporary slip road off the Princes Highway to allow for safe access to, and egress from, the site compound.

Due to the proximity of the site to the Princes Highway this work will be carried out at night (subject to weather and site conditions) on the following dates:

- **Wednesday 18 and Thursday 19 March from 6pm to 7am**

Traffic control will be in place during this time and every effort will be made to reduce noise impacts during this work.
