

# Waterfall Enabling Work Project Night work May – June 2020

## Notification of night work 26 to 28 May and 2 to 4 June 2020

The safety of our project team and the community is our top priority. In line with current Australian Government guidelines around slowing the spread of Coronavirus and social distancing, all work will be carried out at a safe physical distance where possible and necessary hygiene practices will be observed.

Further to our monthly notification, the Waterfall Enabling Work Project team will conduct night work to safely install barriers between existing underground utilities in preparation for upcoming piling work.

### **Upcoming night work**

Due to the proximity of the site to the Princes Highway these works will be carried out at night (subject to weather and site conditions) during the following dates:

- Tuesday 26 May, 6pm to 10pm
- Wednesday 27 May and Thursday 28 May, 6pm to 7am
- Tuesday 2 June, 6pm to 10pm
- Wednesday 3 June and Thursday 4 June, 6pm to 7am

This is required for the following activities:

- installation of a barrier between existing underground utilities and future piling sites within the rail corridor
- delivery and removal of materials.

Traffic control will be in place during this time. Every effort will be made to reduce noise impacts during this work.

#### **Minimising community impact**

Some of the work will be noisy and we try to reduce the noise when we can. Some ways we do this include:

- conducting noisy work in the early evening when possible
- using squawkers rather than beepers on vehicles
- only using noisy machinery when we absolutely have to
- directing noise and lights away from residents when we can.
