Waterfall Enabling Work Project Night work April 2020

Additional night work during April 2020

Further to our monthly notification, the Waterfall Enabling Project team will undertake night work for deliveries of large materials and equipment, excavation for the installation of utilities along the Princes Highway, removal of guard rails and installation of traffic barriers. Due to the proximity of the site to the Princes Highway this work will be carried out at night (subject to weather and site conditions). Traffic control will be in place during this time and every effort will be made to reduce noise impacts during this work.

The project is continuing in accordance with current COVID-19 polices. Mitigation measures, including safe working practices, have been implemented.
