

Changed traffic conditions for nightwork on Gilmour Street near Bathurst from 28 May

Transport for NSW is carrying out essential maintenance work on Gilmour Street in Kelso to provide an improve road surface.

The work includes asphaltting on a 460 metre section of Gilmour Street between Eleven Mile Drive and Herford Street. We have included a map to show the location of the work.

To minimise impacts to motorists, we will be working at night between **7pm** and **6am** from **Sunday to Thursday** and expect to complete the work in **three weeks**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

There will be some noise and lighting associated with this work. We will aim to complete noisier activities before **midnight** and direct lighting away from residences where possible.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures, intermittent stopping and 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow up to five minutes extra travel time during this work. Outside of work hours, variable speed limits will be in place and signposted accordingly.
