

Night works in Narrabri at Doctor's Creek Bridge from 16 October

Transport for NSW will be carrying out footpath repair works on the southern side of Doctor's Creek Bridge on the Newell Highway in Narrabri to improve safety.

What work are we doing?

Work will include repairing damage to the pavement footpath on the south-western side of Doctor's Creek Bridge in Narrabri.

When we'll be working

Works will commence from **Monday 16 October 2023**, and is expected to take up to five nights to complete, weather permitting.

Working hours are **7pm to 6am, Monday to Friday.**

Traffic changes

There will be temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Changed traffic conditions including a single lane closure and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place during work hours for the safety of workers and motorists. Outside work hours, both lanes will be open and revert to the posted speed limit. Oversize vehicles or wide loads over 3.5 metres will be restricted from accessing the bridge during the night works.

Please keep to the speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

What this will mean for you

You may notice:

- Lane closures and reduced speed limits.
- Noise from machinery and equipment used to remove loose concrete from the existing kerb
- Lighting from machinery and equipment

Managing our impacts


We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Reducing noise as much as possible by working in stages. Nosier activities will be scheduled on the first night and will take no longer than two to three hours.
- Using lights with a similar luminosity to the existing street lights on either side of the bridge during nightworks.
- Turning off machinery when not in use.
