

## Wolli Creek Power Supply Upgrade

### More Trains, More Services

December 2022 and January 2023

Transport for NSW is building a new substation within the rail corridor to create the necessary power supply to support the increase in the number of trains travelling along the T8 Airport Line in the future. This notification outlines what work we will be carrying out in December 2022 and January 2023.

#### What work are we doing?

In December 2022 and January 2023, the project team will undertake the following activities:

- Continuing to fit out the substation and installing the fence around the substation boundary
- Installing cables, metal fixings and other supporting infrastructure to power the substation
- Relocating shipping containers within the site compound using a crane.

#### When and where we'll be working

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday** and **7am to 1pm on Saturdays**.

We'll be working within the site compounds located at 5A and 25 Lusty Street in Wolli Creek as well as surrounding areas, including Spark Lane and Discovery Point Park. The map overleaf outlines locations of the work and site access points.

#### Out-of-hours work

Some work will take place outside of standard construction hours from:

- **4am Saturday 10 December through to 10pm on Sunday 11 December 2022**  
and
- **4am Saturday 21 January through to 10pm on Sunday 22 January 2023.**

Out-of-hours work will take place during scheduled Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains will be running. Scheduling construction work outside of standard construction hours enables our project team to complete the activities safely.

All construction work is weather permitting and subject to change.

#### What will this mean for you?

During construction, you may notice:

- Increased workers and vehicles in and near the site compounds
- Noise from machinery and equipment
- Parking restrictions of around six parking spaces on Henderson Road, Turrella for the use of plant and equipment
- Traffic controllers will be in place on Spark Lane and in Discovery Point Park to assist with the safe management of traffic during the out-of-hours work occurring on **Saturday 21 January and Sunday 22 January 2023.**

Please note we will contact any directly impacted residents with information about scheduled work.

#### Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to minimise impacts to the community and the environment. This includes:

- Fencing for safety and security
- Minimising noise as much as possible
- Directing lighting towers away from residential properties to minimise light spill
- Adhering to strict environmental conditions relating to vibration and dust management.
