Wolli Creek Power Supply Upgrade Project



What are we doing in Wolli Creek?

Transport for NSW is building a new substation near Wolli Creek Station. This upgrade will create the necessary power supply to support the increase in the number of trains travelling along the T8 Airport line in the future.

We are also extending the platform canopy at Wolli Creek Station to increase weather protection and encourage customers to use the full length of the platform, reducing crowding at busy times.

What happened in April?

During April, we completed asbestos removal, piling work and installation of service utilities. We also installed electrical and communications containment units, and lightingpower to the platform at Wolli Creek Station.

What's planned next?

This month, the following work be will carried out:

- investigation and installation of service utilities in the rail corridor and near Guess Avenue
- minor vegetation clearing
- installation of permanent down pipes
- Installation of bird proofing to new platform elements

Changes to construction hours

To support the construction industry through Coronavirus, the NSW Government have extended an amendment to the legislation regarding standard construction hours. This amendment enables activities across all our sites to be carried out between 7am and 6pm on weekdays, weekends and public holidays.



When will work take place?

During May our construction activities will take place during standard construction hours and the scope of work will largely occur within the rail corridor as shown on the map above.

How do we consider the community?

project team understands construction activities may cause some disruption for the community and we will seek to minimise impacts as much as possible.

When carrying out our work, the project team utilises a noise assessment of the programmed activities to determine the noise to be generated and the appropriate mitigation measures to be put in place. We will also continue to ensure we adhere to strict environmental conditions relating to vibration and dust management.
