Kiama, Wollongong, Coniston, Albion Park, Kembla Grange

June - July 2023

The More Trains, More Services program is delivering platform extensions and asset upgrades between Sydney's CBD and the South Coast to support the introduction of the Mariyung fleet.

What work are we doing?

In June and July 2023, we will be completing work across several locations along the south coast. Upcoming construction activities include:

Kiama

- extending the Kiama Siding (low speed access track adjacent to Kiama Smash Repairs) by 20 metres
- excavation activities
- constructing a retaining wall along the embankment near Barney Street Bridge
- installing a boundary fence adjacent to the Kiama Smash Repairs
- extending the drivers' walkway and installing additional lighting
- construction of new underground cable routes and drainage upgrades
- removing old track and preparing for the reinstatement of new track
- completing overhead wiring and signalling upgrades
- spoil and vegetation removal.

Coniston and Wollongong

- completing site investigation work for future planning of design, construction, environment and safety controls
- installing overhead wiring structures, signalling equipment, and buried cable routes

- removing existing and installing new bridge screens on Bridge Street, Coniston
- removing track equipment
- installing signage and lighting
- construction of driver walkways
- removing redundant cables under Coniston Bridge, at Coniston Station, and Wollongong Yard
- line marking work on the station platform
- wiring work and steelwork removal.

Albion Park Substation

- installing fencing around the substation, steel platforms and cabling infrastructure
- installing a reinforced concrete slab

Kembla Grange Substation

- installing buried cable routes
- replacing overhead wiring infrastructure
- cable, concrete and steelwork, including installation of cable containment infrastructure

Standard construction hours

Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday.**

Weekend work

We will be completing some weekend work in June and July 2023 between:

- **6pm Friday 2 June and 7am Monday 5 June** at Kiama, Albion Park and Kembla Grange.
- **6pm Friday 30 June and 7am Monday 3 July** between Wollongong and Coniston.



Why we work outside of standard construction hours

We schedule work outside of standard construction hours during Sydney Trains trackwork periods when no trains are running, minimising disruptions to commuter services and improving the safety of our construction team and customers.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- workers and vehicles
- traffic controllers and signage
- noise from machinery and equipment.

Managing our impacts

We understand construction activities may cause disruption to our closest neighbours, so every effort will

be made to minimise the impacts where possible, including:

- turning off equipment when not in use and using non-tonal reversing alarms to reduce potential noise impacts
- locating equipment as far away from residents and businesses as possible
- directing lighting away from residents
- conducting on-site monitoring to enable compliance with strict environmental conditions relating to noise, vibration and dust management.

We are going paperless

We are committed to integrating sustainable practices into our projects and are starting to phase out the distribution of paper notifications.
