# Work Continuing at James Ruse Drive and Prospect Street, Rosehill from Tuesday 28 February 2023

Transport for NSW is upgrading the traffic lights at the intersection of James Ruse Drive and Prospect Street, Rosehill. The location of the work is shown on the map overleaf.

We had expected to complete work by Tuesday 28 February. However, due to unforeseen circumstances we will continue to be on site for up to **five night shifts** between **Tuesday 28 February** and **Friday 21 April 2023**, weather permitting.

Our work hours will continue to be between **8pm** and **5am** from **Sunday** to **Friday**. We will work up to five nights a week to get the work done as quickly as possible. We will not work on public holidays.

There will be some temporary traffic changes to make sure the work zone is safe. Lane closures will be in place and may affect travel times.

Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
