


Beverly Hills Commuter Car Park

Commuter Car Park Program June 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Bidjigal people of the Eora Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Transport for NSW is delivering the Beverly Hills Commuter Car Park, with approximately 200 commuter parking spaces to provide you with more convenient access to public transport and to help ease the congestion on our roads. Site establishment is continuing, with main work to commence in the coming months.

What's planned

The Beverly Hills Commuter Car Park on Edgbaston Road will feature:

- A multi-storey commuter car park with approximately 200 commuter parking spaces
- Lift and stairwell access to each level
- CCTV, lighting and wayfinding signage for safety and security
- Provision for future electric vehicle charging points
- Park&Ride infrastructure (Opal card-operated boom gates)
- Upgrade of existing stairs linking the existing car park to King Georges Road
- Four additional accessible parking spaces located on Tooronga Terrace
- Landscaping.

What work are we doing?

In June, site establishment work will continue for the new commuter car park in Beverly Hills.

Work includes:

Demolition of existing asphalt, excavation and piling

- Utility relocations within the site
- Preparation work to install a tower crane
- Concrete pouring
- Tree trimming (if required)

Changes to parking

The existing Edgbaston Road car park will be closed to commuters during construction of the new commuter car park. During construction, onstreet parking is available on:

- Morgan Street
- Frederick Avenue
- Edgbaston Road
- Hampden Street
- Melvin Street
- Norfolk Avenue

When we will be working

Working hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm, Saturday.

We are working in and around the existing car park at 2-2a Edgbaston Road, as shown on the map over the page.



Managing our impacts

Our work may be noisy at times, and we have put measures in place to reduce the impact of this noise, including turning equipment off when not in use and using non-tonal reversing beepers for trucks used on site.

You may notice an increase in worker and vehicle movements and noise from machinery and equipment in the area.
