



Early works update: Tumby Road and Central Coast Highway intersection upgrade

September 2023

Early works to prepare for the Central Coast Highway and Tumby Road intersection upgrade will soon be complete.

Transport is carrying out final works between **8am to 6pm from September** to return the work area to its original state.

Some works will be carried out at night under traffic control for the safety of our workers, the night works will occur from **6pm to 5am for about three nights from mid September**. We will contact residents who would be directly affected by these works.

The final works involve shifting the safety barriers away from the road, installing utilities, changing line marking and signage. Throughout the day, there will be ongoing work to maintain environmental controls, landscaping and vegetation management.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates noise and light. We will make every effort to minimise noise by staging the work at different locations and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Traffic changes

After the safety barriers are relocated, the Central Coast Highway will return to its original arrangement. From 50 metres north of the Pacific Garden Hotel to the Wamberal fruit shop, we will be:

- Re-opening the southbound shoulder and overtaking lane
- Allowing the right hand turn into the Pacific Garden Hotel from the southbound lane
- Returning the speed limit return to 60km/h
- Maintaining shoulder space for cyclists.
