



Bridge nightworks at Little Hartley on 7 December

Coxs River Road Upgrade

December 2023



Transport for NSW acknowledges people of the Wiradjuri Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Coxs River Road upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all local and highway road users, commuters and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW's contractor, Ertech, is carrying out the works at Little Hartley for the Coxs River Road Upgrade.

We have scheduled nightwork (early hours of the morning) to allow the concrete for the bridge piers to be poured and set during the day.

What work are we doing?

We will be building the main central support for the bridge over Coxs River Road. This requires pouring approximately 220 cubic metres of concrete which will be placed, vibrated to compact and remove air pockets, and finished.

We have planned the work to start during the early hours of the morning, progressing into the regular day shift, and finishing in the early afternoon. This will allow the concrete to set and cure under optimum temperature conditions.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be completing this work on **Wednesday 7 December**, weather permitting, adjacent to the intersection of Coxs River Road and the Great Western Highway.

Working hours for this activity will be from approximately **3am to 6pm**.

What will this mean for you?

Most of this work will have minimal impact on residents. However, you may notice:

- Plant moving in and out of the project site
- Concrete trucks and pumps
- Concrete vibrators
- Onsite lighting

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Fencing work areas for safety and security
- Directing lighting away from residential areas where possible
- Reducing our noise as much as possible by working in stages and turning off machinery when not in use.
