Truck deliveries at Little Hartley from 21 November

Coxs River Road Upgrade

November 2023

Transport for NSW acknowledges people of the Wiradjuri Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Coxs River Road upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all local and highway road users, commuters and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW's contractor, Ertech, is carrying out the works at Little Hartley for the Coxs River Road Upgrade.

We have scheduled nightwork to allow for the safe delivery of Super T bridge girders over a two-week period.

What work are we doing?

During this time trucks will be travelling through the night to deliver the Super T bridge girders to site in the early mornings.

Delivery has been planned for the early hours of the morning due to the size of the girders and to minimise interruption to highway traffic.

These trucks will enter the site at the eastern end behind the Lollybug and stop beside Coxs River Road.

Once regular day work hours begin a crane will lift and unload the girders.

We do not expect the delivery in the early morning to be noisy for residents.

When and where we'll be working

We'll be working between **21 November to 5 December 2023,** weather permitting.

Working hours are **3am to 5am, Monday night to Friday morning**.

What will this mean for you?

Most of this work will have minimal impact on residents. However, you will notice:

- Plant moving in and out of the project site
- Oversize truck and police escorts
- Onsite lighting
- Traffic control and reduced speed limits in place, please allow an additional five minutes for your travel time.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.


This includes:
