

Extended closure of Browns Gap Road at Little Hartley until 19 December

Coxs River Road Upgrade

November 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges people of the Wiradjuri Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Coxs River Road upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all local and highway road users, commuters and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW's head contractor, Ertech, is continuing works at Little Hartley for the Coxs River Road Upgrade.

What work are we doing?

Due to wet weather and program changes, we need additional time to complete the upgrade of the Browns Gap Road intersection with the Great Western Highway and the realignment to the existing highway.

To enable this work to be carried out safely, we will need to maintain the temporary closure of Browns Gap Road for a further three weeks.

Browns Gap Road will now reopen by 19 December 2023.

During this time, we will continue to undertake the following activities:

- Sealing and asphalting
- Installing drainage
- General earthworks

During the closure we will detour traffic via Mid Hartley Road.

We have included a map over the page showing the detour and location of the work.

When and where we'll be working

Work at the intersection of Browns Gap Road and the Great Western Highway will continue up until 19 December 2023, weather permitting.

Working hours remain between **7am and 6pm**, **Monday to Friday**.

If we need to do work outside of these hours we will notify you in advance.

What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- Noise from machinery and equipment.
- Plant moving in and out of the project site.

A detour via Mid Hartley Road will be in place to access Browns Gap Road. Please allow an additional five minutes for your travel time.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Fencing work areas for safety and security.
- Reducing our noise as much as possible by working in stages and turning off machinery when not in use.
- Controlling dust through dust suppression measures like watercarts.
- Maintaining property access.
