


Work continues at Little Hartley October 2023

Coxs River Road Upgrade

October 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges people of the Wiradjuri Nation as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respects to Elders past and present.

The Coxs River Road upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all local and highway road users, commuters and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW's contractor, Ertech is continuing works at Little Hartley for the Coxs River Road Upgrade.

What work are we doing?

Construction work will continue across the site and the following activities have been planned over the next six to eight weeks.

Across the Project Site

- General earthworks will continue.
- Installing drainage.

East of Coxs River Road

- Drilling and piling for the retaining wall will continue.
- Performing soil nailing and applying shotcrete.
- Constructing a basin.
- Building the bridge will continue.
- Undertaking borehole investigations alongside the Great Western Highway.

Coxs River Road to Baaners Lane

- Constructing a water retention and treatment basin.
- Constructing a temporary side track alongside Coxs River Road.

West of Baaners Lane

Constructing a water retention and treatment basin.

Around Browns Gap Road

- Constructing a hardstand at Hartley Fresh.
- Installing a concrete footpath.
- Undertaking asphalt works.

When and where we'll be working

We will continue working under our standard working hours between **7am and 6pm, Monday to Friday**.

Should we need to do work outside of these hours we will notify you in advance.

What will this mean for you?

Most of this work will have minimal impact on residents. However, you may notice:

- Noise from machinery and equipment
- Plant movement in and out of the project site
- Traffic control and reduced speed limits in place. Please allow an additional five minutes for your travel time.

Managing our impacts

We aim to manage our work to avoid impacts to the community and the environment.

This includes:

- Fencing work areas for safety and security.
- Reducing our noise as much as possible by working in stages and turning off machinery when not in use.
