# Temporary Closure Browns Gap Road at Little Hartley from 6 November to 27 November

Coxs River Road Upgrade

## The Coxs River Road upgrade will reduce congestion and improve safety and accessibility for all local and highway road users, commuters and pedestrians.

Transport for NSW's head contractor, Ertech, is continuing works at Little Hartley for the Coxs River Road Upgrade.

# What work are we doing?

We are upgrading the Browns Gap Road intersection with the Great Western Highway and realigning the existing highway.

To enable this work to be carried out safely, **we will temporarily close Browns Gap Road** near the intersection with the Great Western Highway **for approximately three weeks**.

During this time, we will undertake the following activities:

- Sealing and asphalting
- Installing drainage
- General earthworks

#### During the closure we will detour traffic via Mid Hartley Road.

We have included a map over the page showing the detour and location of the work.

# When and where we'll be working

We'll be working for up to three weeks from the **6 November to 27 November 2023,** weather permitting.

Working hours are between **7am and 6pm**, **Monday to Friday**.

Should we need to do work outside of these hours we will notify you in advance.

# What will this mean for you?

- A detour via Mid Hartley Road will be in place to access Browns Gap Road. Please allow an additional five minutes for your travel time.
- Noise from machinery and equipment.
- Plant moving in and out of the project site.


# Managing our impacts

- Controlling dust through dust suppression measures such as watercarts.
