

## Continuing work on Dawson River Bridge, Manning River Drive, Cundletown from Monday 6 March

The NSW Government is investing in essential maintenance to preserve the structural integrity of Dawson River Bridge and to reduce future maintenance costs.

Transport for NSW and construction partner RMP Abrasive Blasting are continuing the final stage of work which includes painting the bridge and steel and concrete repairs as part of a painting and maintenance project.

Transport for NSW started work on Dawson River Bridge in late April 2021. Due to continuing weather impacts we have experienced delays to the completion of the repainting project. Work on Dawson River Bridge is expected to be completed in **May 2023**.

We will be continuing work to complete steel repairs, painting and remove containment and scaffolding and expect to complete these activities in two months, weather permitting.

To minimise traffic disruptions, and to ensure the safety of workers and road users, some of the steel repair work will be carried out at night. Night work will be completed between **7pm and 5am** from **Tuesday 7 March**. Night work is expected to be complete in one week, weather permitting.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times. We have included a map to show the work location below.

### How will the work affect you?

The work involves the use of machinery which will generate some noise and light. We will make every effort to minimise noise and light by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

### Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Single lane closures, stop/slow traffic arrangements and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place between **9am** and **3pm** and may affect travel times. There will be no bridge closures or detours during or outside work hours.

**During night work short stoppages may be required and will affect travel times. Electronic message boards will be in place to advise motorists of traffic changes.**

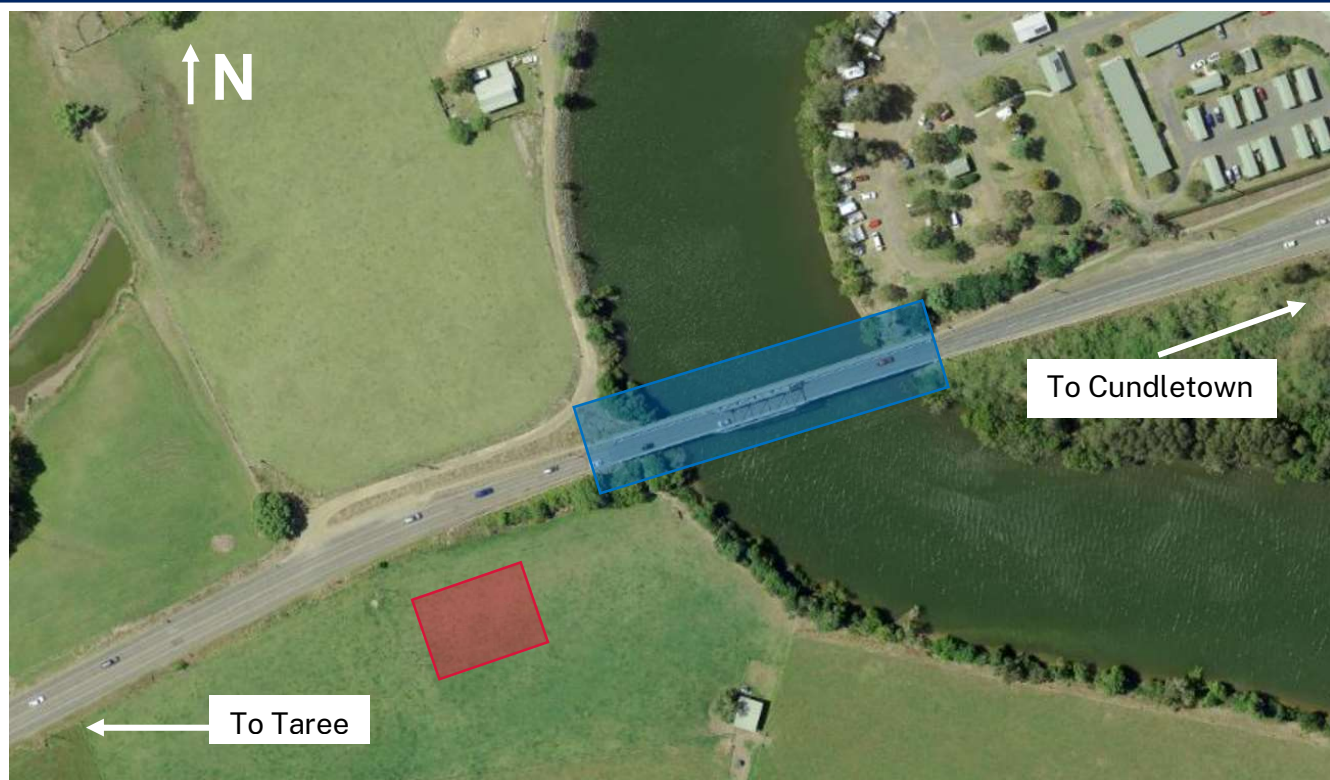
