Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

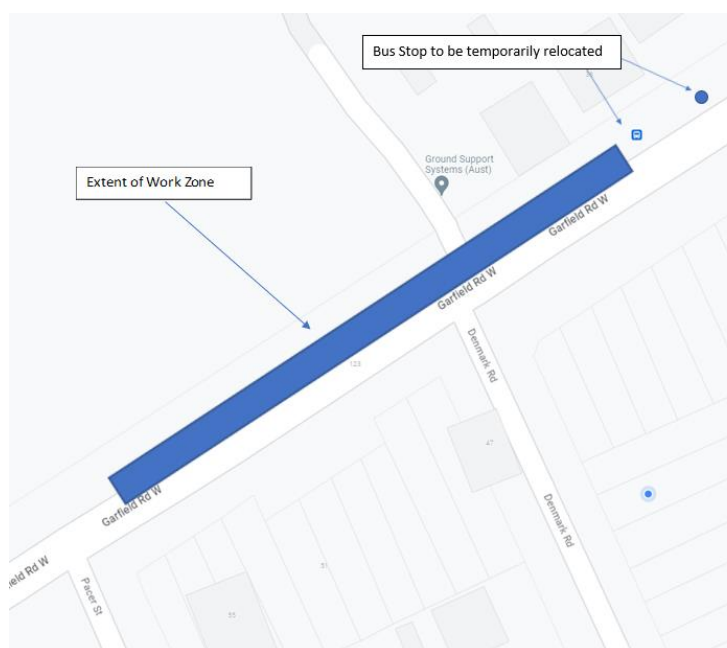
Transport for NSW is continuing work on the Denmark Link Road upgrade.

### What work are we doing?

As part of required electricity asset relocation works, Transport for NSW will need to install four new power poles along Garfield Road West.

This will require drilling new holes. We will carry out this work at night to reduce traffic disruption and any risks to the workers and road users during the day.

### When and where we'll be working

The work will be carried out on a section of Garfield Road West, adjacent to Denmark Road from **7pm 14 August to 5am 15 August**.

The eastbound traffic lane will be closed to traffic and will be maintained via contraflow arrangement.

Motorists should follow signs and traffic controllers' directions.

### Managing our effects

Equipment used for these activities include heavy and light vehicles, rollers, excavators, graders, bobcats and hand and power tools. We will lessen any noise disturbance as much as possible by:

- Using non-tonal beepers on reversing vehicles
- Turning off machinery when not in use.
