



Start of Stage 3 works for Denmark Link Road from 13 June

Community update

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

Denmark Link Road is a proposed new link road between Garfield Road West, Riverstone and the Westminster Street bridge, Schofields.

This new link road aims to alleviate traffic congestion along Garfield Road West around the railway level crossing at Riverstone and provide an alternate local connection for light vehicles to cross the Richmond railway line, to avoid the Riverstone town centre.

Stage 1 and Stage 2 works are well underway on the Denmark Link Road Project, with Stage 3 works commencing Tuesday, 13 June.

The main work is being delivered in five stages, with each stage taking between two to three months to complete with some overlap between stages. The work has been staged to lessen the disruption to the community and traffic.

What work are we doing?

From **Tuesday 13 June**, we will be starting major work for Stage 3. This will include utility relocations, drainage, bulk earthworks, and stabilisation. We will commence works in a staged process starting from the northeast side of Denmark Road.

Once this section of work is complete, we will then commence work on the southwest side of Denmark Road. It will take approximately four

weeks to complete works on both sides of Denmark Road.

During the construction phase, **Denmark Road will temporarily become a one-way street and residents will be required to use Creek Street to access their properties, and travel northwest towards Garfield Road West to exit their properties.**

We will also continue to upgrade Denmark Road and the new Denmark Link Road as well as a section of West Parade northwest of Bridge Street as part of our Stage 1 works.

Stage 2 upgrade works including on Carlton Street and West Parade are ongoing.

We will carry out the following works:

- demolish the existing road pavement and replace it with new pavement
- construct new drainage systems
- utility adjustments
- kerb and gutter construction.

When and where we'll be working

We will be working between Denmark Road, West Parade, Trevithick Street and Carlton Street from



Tuesday 13 June as we continue upgrading the roads. This work will be carried out during the day. Our work hours are **7am-6pm Monday to Friday** and **8am-1pm on Saturdays**.

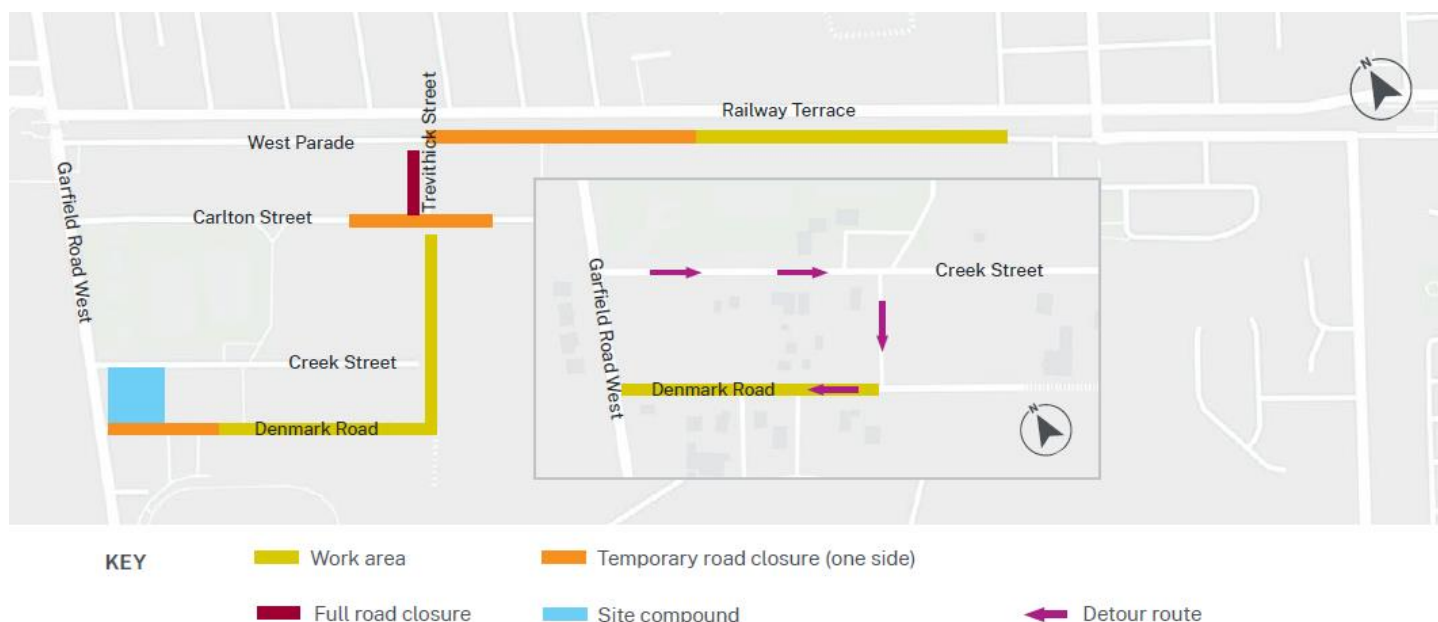
Traffic changes

As we are commencing upgrade works in front of properties on Denmark Road, there will be temporary changes to access for some residents – they will be contacted individually by Burton Contractors who will explain the changes.

Access to residential properties and businesses will always be maintained.

Trevithick Street, part of Carlton Street and a southbound section of West Parade, will remain closed as we continue to upgrade the road.

Our work may be noisy at times, but we will do everything we can to lessen the disturbance to surrounding residents and businesses by using non-tonal beepers on reversing vehicles and turning off machinery when not in use.
