

# **Doonside Station Upgrade Community Update**

## Transport Access Program October 2023





Transport for NSW acknowledges the Dharug people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pay respects to Elders past and present.

#### What work are we doing in October?

Work includes:

- Landscaping and upgrading the footpaths around the station
- Public domain works
- Line marking for new accessibility car spots and kiss and ride spaces
- Installing electrical and communication services
- Installing wayfinding and signage
- Fit out of lifts
- Testing and commissioning systems.

#### When and where we'll be working

In October, work at the station will continue Monday to Friday from 7am until 6pm, 7.30am until 5.30pm on Saturdays and Sundays.

### What will this mean for you?

You may notice:

- At times there will be periods of high noise
- Footpath closure: the footpath on Cross Street adjacent to the station entrance, will be closed at times to allow for civil works. The footpath on Eastwood Lane will also be closed at times for electrical works. Traffic

- control will be in place to guide pedestrians around the work area
- Increase in construction traffic: construction vehicles will access the rail corridor via the access gate on School Parade. At times, temporary parking removal will be required to provide access
- Laydown areas: these secured areas on Coghlan Crescent and Rosenthal Street are required to store materials and support work outside the rail corridor.

#### Changes to scheduled works

Work schedules are subject to change due to permits, weather, and site conditions. Further notification will be provided should there be a significant change to the construction program.

#### Managing our work

We aim to manage our work to limit our effect on the community and the environment. This includes:

- Reducing our noise as much as possible
- Using noise blankets where possible, replacing reversing beepers with clickers
- Using traffic control and signage
- Using directional lighting pointed away from residential properties wherever possible.
