Commuter Car Park Program: Edmondson Park

Construction progress on the Edmondson Park North Commuter Car Park

Construction is underway on the Edmondson Park North Commuter Car Park, which will provide approximately 900 new parking spaces. This will result in a net increase of over 700 additional parking spaces for transport customers when the existing car park to the north of the station is closed to the public.

Project Update

Structural work for the new Edmondson Park North Commuter Car Park progressed well during December and January. The construction of the first two levels was complete and concreting work for the lift and stair walls has also continued.

Upcoming work

The following work activities are planned for February:

- concrete pours for levels three and four of the new car park
- installing perimeter scaffold
- work to modify the access road

Equipment to be used will include excavators, rollers, road saws, graders, tipping trucks, concrete mixers, concrete pump trucks, service vehicles, various delivery vehicles, mobile cranes, tower cranes, forklifts, generators, and hand tools.

Extended work hours

During February, approximately eight major concrete pours are planned to occur on site for levels three and four of the new car park. Whilst most of these concrete pours will be undertaken during standard construction hours, finishing work may need to extend past the standard hours due to the size of the concrete slabs.

There may be some noise impacts associated with this work and every effort will be made to minimise disruption to nearby residents. We apologise for any inconvenience caused.

Construction hours

Standard work hours are between 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturday. Deliveries will be scheduled outside of peak times wherever possible to minimise disruption to pedestrians and motorists.

Sustainability initiatives

Several sustainability initiatives have been implemented during construction to date. Some examples include:

- separating construction waste to assist in the resource recovery process
- constructing elements such as retaining walls out of recycled concrete blocks
- capturing rainwater for reuse on site to suppress dust
