Upcoming work

The following work is planned to occur in March:

- staged construction of the new roundabout at the intersection of Old Bathurst Road and Smith Street
- relocation of water mains on Old Bathurst Road requiring temporary road closures (please refer to details below)
- construction of new footpaths including landscaping and fencing
- sandstone wall construction and general construction work within the new car park


Minor traffic flow changes will be made as required, and traffic controllers and signage will be in place for the safety of motorists and workers. Some short periods of daytime lane closure may be required on Old Bathurst Road, however access in both directions will be maintained.

Night work in March


A section of **Old Bathurst Road between Great Western Highway and Smith Street will be closed for night work between 9pm and 5am on weeknights for up to 10 nights until Friday 31 March 2023** (please see detour map overleaf). This is to allow relocation of a large water main and work on the new roundabout on Old Bathurst Road. Workers will be on site from 6pm each night and traffic control will be in place.

Construction equipment will include lighting towers, excavators, bobcat, mobile crane, tip trucks, concrete mixer, asphalt machine, service and delivery vehicles, generators, compactor, hand tools.
