
# **Epping Bridge Project**

# Site investigation work from Monday 11 December 2023

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wallumedegal people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The Australian and NSW governments are jointly providing \$220 million in funding to replace Epping Bridge to ease congestion, reduce travel times and improve safety for road users.

As part of early planning, investigation works are being undertaken in the road and rail corridors. This includes geotechnical investigation work.

### When and where are we working?

Between Monday 11 December and Wednesday 20 December 2023, geotechnical investigation works will be undertaken around Epping Station. This includes work along Beecroft Road, High Street and Bridge Street. For further information on our work locations, please refer to the map overleaf.

#### Day and night time working hours

Day time work will be carried out from Tuesday 12 December to Thursday 14 December between 7am and 3:30pm, weather permitting.

Night time work will be carried out for up to two shifts a week from Monday 11 December to Wednesday 20 December 2023 between 9pm and 5am the next day, weather permitting.

We will return to site in January 2024 to carry out further investigation work. We will notify the community again before commencing this additional work.

#### What work are we doing?

Our work will involve carrying out a site survey and geotechnical site investigations. Work activities, include:

establishing a temporary work site

- using machinery to conduct borehole drilling and excavating activities
- restoring the area once our investigation work has concluded.

The equipment and machinery required for the work will include:

- vacuum excavator
- · concrete cutter
- drill rig
- trucks and light vehicles.

#### What will this mean for you?

While our work is being carried out, you may notice:

- workers in high visibility clothing and vehicles
- temporary changes to traffic, cycling and pedestrian access, including lane closures
- · site noise.

#### Managing our impacts

Our work may be noisy at times, however we will take steps to reduce any impacts and disruption to community, including:

- using non-tonal reversing and movement alarms on our vehicles
- using quieter equipment where possible and turning off equipment and vehicles when not in use
- locating equipment as far away from residents and businesses as possible.
