


# Essential Maintenance work on Flint Street from Monday 28 August 2023

Transport for NSW acknowledges the Wiradjuri people as the Traditional Custodians of the lands on which we work and pays respect to Elders past and present.

The NSW Government is funding essential maintenance work on Flint Street in Forbes.

#### What work are we doing?

Transport for NSW will carry out the work, which includes heavy patching.

#### Work includes:

- Using heavy machinery along the road
- Pavement rehabilitation
- Restoring the site when our works are finished.

#### When and where we'll be working

We'll be working along Flint Street from the intersection of Flint and Bridge Streets towards Forbes Iron Bridge.

Work will commence **Monday 28 August and continue for two weeks, weather permitting.** 

Working hours are 7am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 7am to 1pm, Saturday.

We will let you know in advance if we need to do any other work outside these times.

## Managing our impacts

The work will involve the use of machinery which will generate some noise.

We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

# What will this mean for you?

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

You may notice:

- Workers and vehicles
- Traffic controllers and signage
- Road closures and reduced speed limits
- Noise from machinery and equipment.

Single lane closures and a 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours, which may affect travel times.

Outside of work hours, the speed limit will return to 50km/h.

When works are completed, the speed limit will return to the posted speed.

Motorists should allow an extra five-minutes travel time during this work.


Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
