

Update on new 50km/h speed limit along Frederick Street and Milton Street, Ashfield

What date is important for motorists and local residents?

From Wednesday, 10 May 2023, a new speed limit of 50 km/h will come into effect for all motorists along Frederick Street and Milton Street, between Parramatta Road and Georges River Road, Ashfield. (Location map overleaf.)

Why is this work taking place, when will it occur and how will we manage it?

Transport for NSW is installing several 50km/h speed zone signs along Frederick Street and Milton Street, between Parramatta Road and Georges River Road to provide a safer road for all motorists and pedestrians. We will be onsite for **one night shift** between **Wednesday, 3 May and Wednesday, 10 May 2023**. Work will be carried out within the hours of **8pm and 5am**. No work will occur on Saturdays or public holidays.

Scope of work includes:

Removal of existing speed pavement markings and replacing with new 50km/h pavement markings.

Please follow the guidance of traffic controllers and temporary signage whilst work is being carried out.

Other Traffic Changes and Information


- Partial lane closures will be in place between Georges River Road and Parramatta Road
- Frederick Street will remain open to traffic.
- Mobile electronic message signs will provide advanced warning on speed change dates for commuters.
- Bus routes will remain unchanged and will run as normal along Frederick Street.
- Residents and businesses along Frederick Street will have full access to their properties at all times.
- Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.

Other road works completed along Frederick Street

This work is part of a road maintenance programme that also includes:

- Resurfacing of Frederick Street, between Parramatta Road and Liverpool Road.
- Installation of electronic road sign to provide motorists with advanced notification of traffic conditions in the new extensions of the M4 and M8 motorways.

Local residents would have recently received a community notification about these road improvement projects via letterbox drop.
