Temporary night closures of the Great Western Highway at Mount Victoria from Wednesday 22 March

Night work is taking place on the Great Western Highway between Mount Victoria and Lithgow.

The essential maintenance work includes slope and culvert inspections, signage installation, pavement repairs, crack sealing, routine vegetation clearing and drainage work on the Great Western Highway. We have included a map to show the location of the closure and the detour.

We will be working between 8pm and 5am on:

Wednesday 22 March and Thursday 23 March

Wednesday 29 March and Thursday 30 March

The work is expected to be completed over **four nights**, weather permitting. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work will be carried out at night to minimise traffic disruptions. The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use and direct lighting away from residences where possible

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

The Great Western Highway will be closed in both directions between Mount Victoria and Lithgow. A detour via Chifley Road and Darling Causeway will be in place for all traffic during this time. Access will be maintained for emergency services and local residents to the closure points.

Motorists should allow up to 15 minutes extra travel time during this work.


