

Traffic and pedestrian path changes during our work

Temporary traffic changes will be in place to ensure the work zone is safe for road workers and motorists. Please follow the direction of traffic controllers and follow traffic signs. Motorists may experience minor delays due to these changed traffic conditions.

What happens next?

Early works started in March 2023 and will be ongoing until the end of June 2023. This includes:

- vegetation clearing and mulching across the project
- traffic barrier installation
- site compound establishment
- geotechnical investigations
- utility investigation and relocation
- construction signage installation
- earthworks

There will be a speed zone reduction to 60km/h on Newbridge Road and Milperra Road, and a signposted diversion to the shared pedestrian and cyclists path, on the south-west corner of Henry Lawson Drive and Newbridge Road. The bus stop on Milperra Road east bound (221443)

will be temporarily relocated, 90m to the east along Milperra Road. Please refer to bus stop signage for the new location.

Our day work hours are between **7am and 6pm** from **Monday to Friday** and between **8am to 1pm** on **Saturday**. We will not work on Sundays and during public holidays. Some of our work will need to be carried out at night to minimise traffic disruptions and reduce safety risks to workers and road users.

When needed, we will work up to five nights a week, weather permitting and excluding public holidays. Our night time work is from **Sunday to Thursday** from **8pm to 5am** the next day. There will be noise and disruption associated with this work. We will make every effort to minimise impact to the local community and motorists in the area. This includes completing noisier activities, like saw-cutting and jack-hammering by midnight, where practicable.

Henry Lawson Drive Upgrade – Stage 1A

Transport for NSW is upgrading Henry Lawson Drive Stage 1A, between Tower Road, Bankstown Aerodrome and Auld Avenue, Milperra.

Henry Lawson Drive Stage 1A upgrade is part of the program to upgrade Henry Lawson Drive between the Hume Highway and the M5 Motorway to ease congestion and improve safety and connectivity for all road users.

Stage 1A, between Tower Road and Auld Avenue, will provide more capacity for vehicles travelling through the intersection of Henry Lawson Drive, Milperra Road and Newbridge Road.

We are pleased to announce the contract for construction of the Henry Lawson Drive Stage 1A upgrade has been awarded to Quickway Constructions, and work is now underway.


We will continue to keep the community up to date on the different stages of the upgrade.

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Henry Lawson Drive Upgrade Stage 1A improvements between Auld Avenue and Tower Road, Milperra



What does Stage 1A upgrade include?

1 Improvements at Auld Avenue

- Access to Auld Avenue will be maintained as part of the Stage 1A upgrade
- A new link road between Auld Avenue and Keyes Parade is proposed as part of Stage 1B – Henry Lawson Drive Upgrade

2 Improvements to the intersection of Henry Lawson Drive, Milperra Road and Newbridge Road to provide:

- Additional right turn lane on the Milperra Road and Newbridge Road approaches to Henry Lawson Drive
- Removal of the bus only lane on Milperra Road to provide the additional right turn lane onto Henry Lawson Drive

- Additional southbound through lane on Henry Lawson Drive
- Additional right turn lane from Henry Lawson Drive onto Milperra Road

3 Improvements to the intersection of Henry Lawson Drive and Tower Road including:

- Additional right turn lane from Tower Road onto Henry Lawson Drive
- New short left turn lane from Henry Lawson Drive onto Tower Road
- Additional right turn lane from Henry Lawson Drive onto Tower Road
