

# Proposed safety improvements on the Hume Highway at Bookham

The NSW Government is funding these safety improvements to provide a safer road.

## What are we doing?

Transport for NSW is investigating safety improvements at the Hume Highway intersection with Conroy Street at Bookham to improve safety and reduce the likelihood and severity of crashes.

We heard the community's concerns regarding our original proposed changes and installed cameras to monitor the intersection for six months to help us understand driver behaviour. During this period we recorded 681 incidents and we've used this information to update our proposed design, with improving safety at the intersection our priority.

## Proposed design

The updated design includes:

- installing a U-turn bay next to the Hume Highway's southbound lanes, 250 metres east of the intersection
- building a dedicated lane to allow vehicles to safely enter the U-turn bay
- closing the southbound lane on Conroy Street to the recreation grounds
- updating signage for traffic changes.

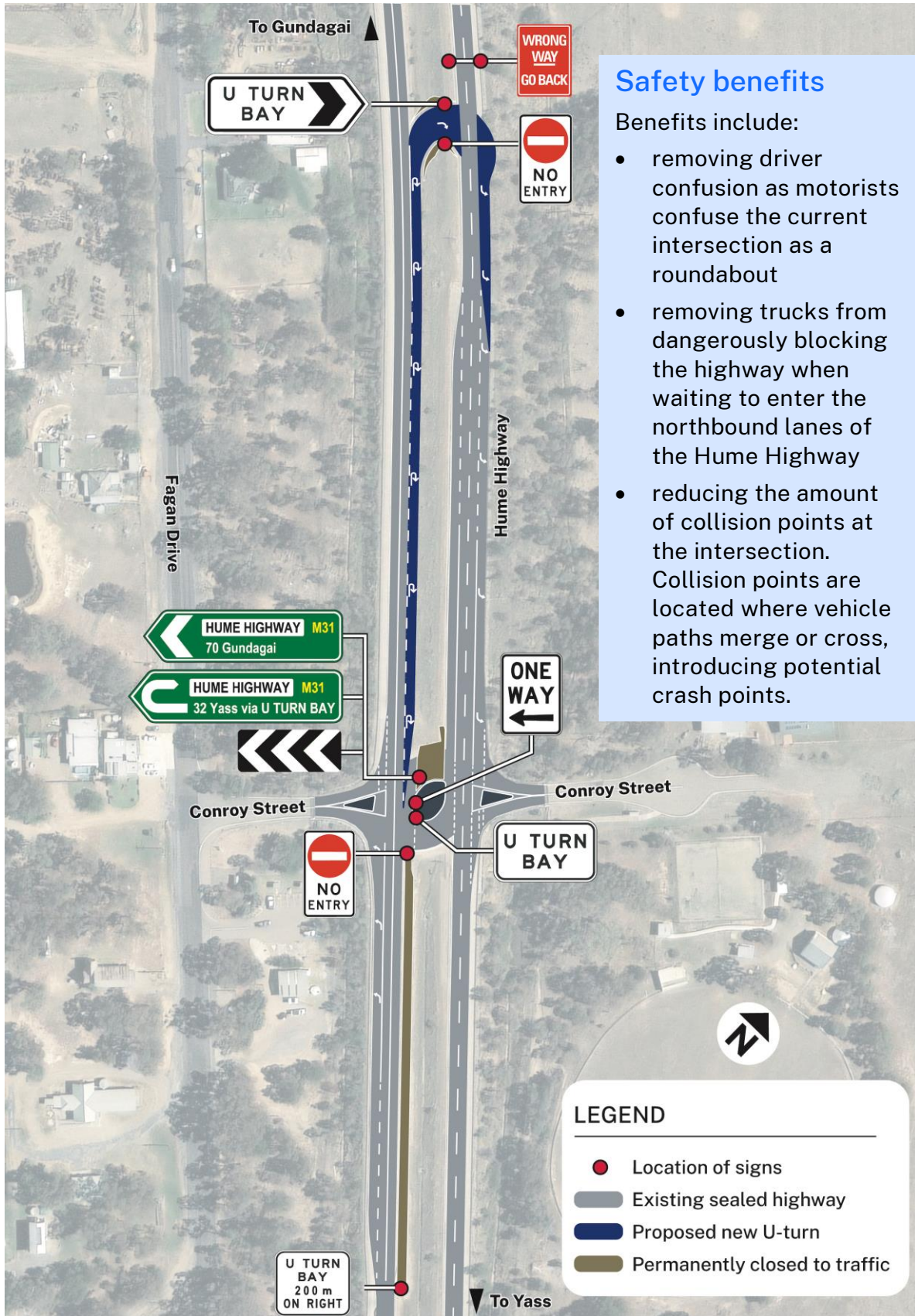
