

Intersection upgrade at Princes Highway between James Street and south of Torrens Street, Blakehurst

Community Update | August 2023



Project completion

Work is now completed on the intersection upgrade at Princes Highway between James Street and south of Torrens Street, Blakehurst.

The upgrade will help reduce delays for motorists, whilst improving safety and pedestrian access at the intersections.

This project is the final project within the Gateway to the South Pinch Points Program, which is an Easing Sydney's Congestion initiative.

The program is linked to the NSW Government's Future Transport Strategy 2056, which acknowledges the vital role transport plays in the land use, tourism and economic development of our towns and cities.

What the upgrade has delivered

- Removal of existing tidal flow arrangement
- Widening of Princes Highway to create four dedicated through lanes travelling northbound and three dedicated through lanes travelling southbound
- Upgrade of the Princes Highway at Water, Bunyala, Church and Torrens streets intersections
- Re-surfacing of the car park located between Water Street and Church Street with additional car spaces added
- Installation of new pedestrian crossings at Bunyala, Water and Torrens streets.
