

## Temporary night time road closure and detour of Jenolan Caves Road at Hampton from Monday 27 March

Essential nightwork will take place on Jenolan Caves Road near Hampton

Work will involve installing fibre optic cable to enable the connection of automated traffic signals. We have included a map to show the location of the works and detour.

The work will be carried out at night between **7pm** and **5am** from **Monday 27 March** and is expected to be completed in three nights, weather permitting.

### How will the work affect you?

The work will involve machinery which generates noise. We will make every effort to minimise this by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

### Traffic changes

A detour will be in place during this work; we have included a map to show the alternate route.

Jenolan Caves Road will be closed at Hampton between Old Bindo Road and Duckamloi Road from 7pm to 5am from Monday 27 March. A detour will be in place via Oberon, Bathurst and Lithgow using Duckmaloi Road, O'Connell Road and the Great Western Highway in both directions. This will add approximately 1 hour and 40 minutes additional travel time.

Traffic control and reduced speed limits will also be in place during and after work hours and may affect travel times. Motorists should allow extra travel time during this work.

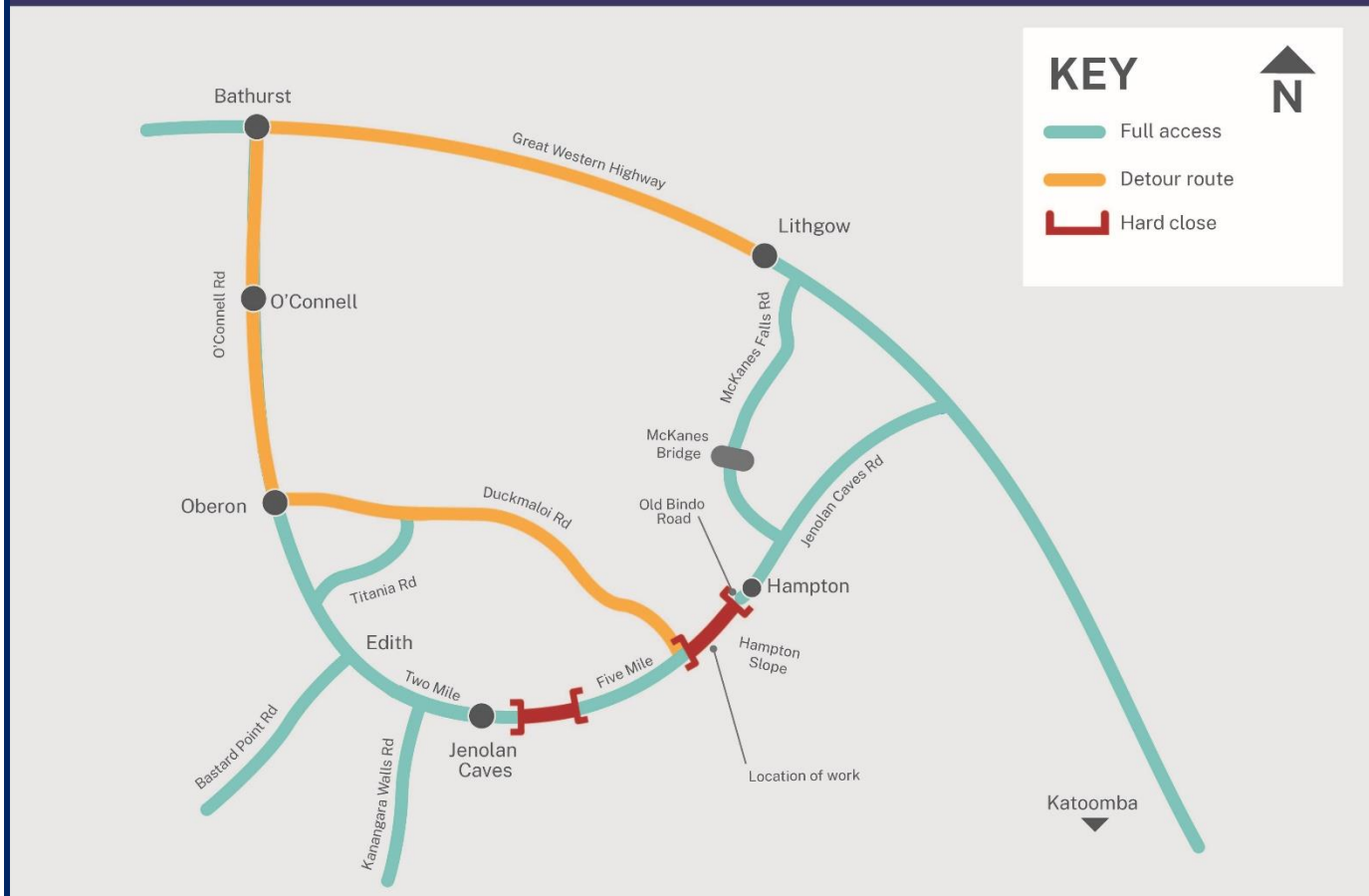
