Work to continue on Junction Bridge on Rouchel Road, Upper Rouchel from Monday 9 October

The NSW Government is funding upgrade work to ensure the safe and reliable operation of the bridge.

Transport for NSW is restarting work on Junction Bridge, which involves replacing timber components of the bridge including the deck and abutments, repainting and sealing of the bridge deck.

Work on the upgrade was delayed due to flooding and is now expected to be completed in **mid-February 2024**, weather permitting.

Work will be carried out between **7am** and **5pm** from **Monday** to **Thursday**. We will let you know in advance if we need to do any work outside these times.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use.

Side access road

To ensure the safety of road users and workers, intermittent closures of Junction Bridge will be in place for the duration of the project. The closures are expected to be scheduled between Monday and Thursday.

A detour will be in place for all vehicles via the side access road, which has been temporarily upgraded to ensure motorists have access during the closures. We have included a map to show the detour arrangements.

The bridge will remain open during significant rain events and flooding. We will use electronic signs to notify motorists of the closure dates.

Traffic changes

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Traffic control and 40km/h speed limit will be in place during work hours and may affect travel times.


