

Monument Track closure

We have closed a section of the Monument Track to allow utilities work and site access for construction of the Kurnell Wharf.

A detour is provided around the eastern side of the site compound, or you can use existing access points within the National Park. See map above. The sealed Monument Track is an even concrete path with gentle hill sections.

The Burrawang walk is a Grade 3 track. View the National Parks website for more details on the track and for National Park gate opening times https://www.nationalparks.nsw. gov.au/things-to-do/walking-tracks/burrawang-walk We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.

The unsealed tracks have rough surfaces including grass, dirt and woodchips, informal steps, and short steep hill sections.

We'll reinstate the Monument Track at the end of construction.
