



Medlow Bath upgrade - tree clearing

Night work from Monday 1 May 2023

Transport for NSW is continuing the Medlow Bath Upgrade - with the first stage of work on the 1.2 kilometre upgrade of the Great Western Highway between Railway Parade and south of Bellevue Crescent now underway.

To allow us to widen the Highway, tree clearing and saw cutting will be carried out during the day between 7am to 5pm from Monday 1 May, and will include three nights on Monday 1 May, Tuesday 2 May and Thursday 4 May from 6pm to 7am, weather permitting. This work is being done at night to reduce traffic impacts on the Highway and for the safety of workers.

Tree clearing will occur along the Great Western Highway between the petrol station and about 400 metres south of Bellevue Crescent.

We will mulch during the day to reduce noise at night. There is no planned work on Sunday or public holidays.

How will the work affect you?

We need to disconnect the power to allow for the work. Two generators will be placed on Delmonte Avenue from Friday 28 April to Monday 9 May to maintain power to houses during the planned power outage. A brief power outage will occur during the morning on Sunday 30 April and again on Sunday 7 May while power is being transferred to and from the generators.

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by arranging the work in stages at different locations, and turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use. If there is any way we can support you during these works, please let us know.

Traffic changes

Traffic control may be in place where necessary along the Great Western Highway during this time with reduced speed limits of 40km/h and temporary shoulder closures.

Motorists are advised to drive to the conditions and follow the directions of signs and traffic control.
