## Work to upgrade Kelly Street, Scone from Sunday 15 October

The NSW Government is funding additional upgrade work to improve the road surface between St Aubins Street and Kingdon Street, to allow Upper Hunter Shire Council to continue work on the Scone CBD Revitalisation Project.

The New England Highway bypass of Scone opened to traffic in March 2020, returning the main street of Scone to local traffic. Upper Hunter Shire Council started the upgrade of Kelly Street to further improve the amenity for the local community in May 2023.

Transport for NSW will be carrying out night work from **Sunday 15 October between 6pm and 5am from Sunday to Thursday.** The work involves saw cutting sections of the road to remove and replace concrete slabs that were not previously replaced during Stage 1 work completed in June and July, 2022. We will also carry out concrete repairs on Kelly Street.

To minimise the impact on motorists, work will be carried out at night between **6pm** and **5am.** We expect to complete this work by late October, weather permitting.

Upper Hunter Shire Council will continue to deliver the second stage of the Kelly Street upgrade, which will involve resurfacing and installing final line marking.

### How will the work affect you?

The work will involve the use of machinery which generates some noise. We will make every effort to minimise noise by turning off machinery and vehicles when not in use and completing noisier activities earlier in the night.

### Traffic impacts

There will be some temporary traffic changes to ensure the work zone is safe.

Lane closures and a reduced speed limit of 40km/h will be in place during work hours which may affect travel times. Motorists should allow up to five minutes of extra travel time.

Northbound traffic will be diverted via Main Street from Kingdon to Susan Street.

Southbound traffic will be detoured via Susan Street, down Main Street and back onto Kelly Street at Kingdon Street.

There will also be some temporary impact to parking on Kelly Street during work hours. We will try to minimise this impact by completing the work at night and working in sections, gradually moving along Kelly Street.
