

Night work continuing on Memorial Avenue at Kellyville from 2 April March 2023

Memorial Avenue is being upgraded to a four-lane road between Old Windsor Road and Windsor Road at Kellyville.

What are we doing?

We will carry out the following works:

- digging, crushing and moving of fill materials and building road pavements
- temporary road pavement and asphaltting work
- installation of stormwater drainage.

Our work schedule

Out-of-hours work will take place between **Sunday 2 and Sunday 30 April** in the following areas, weather permitting.

Activity	Duration
Installation of stormwater, asphaltting and line-marking on Memorial Avenue under the Sydney Metro	2 x 3 nights
Earthworks, installation of stormwater and pavement construction works on the western side of Windsor Road, between Memorial Avenue and Presidents Road	4 x 5 nights
Pavement works, installation of concrete drainage, installation of kerbs and finishing works at the intersection of Old Windsor Road and Sunnyholt Road	2 x 5 nights
Temporary pavement works, asphaltting and line-marking on Memorial Avenue between McCausland Place and Hector Court	2 x 2 nights
Relocation of traffic barriers along Memorial Avenue	1 x 5 nights
Building the connections between the existing road and the new road on Memorial Avenue and moving traffic onto the new road between Old Windsor Road and Hector Court	1 weekend
Building the connections between the existing road and the new road on Memorial Avenue and between Old Windsor Road and Hector Court	2 x 2 nights
Pavement work, concreting, landscaping and other finishing work on Memorial Avenue between Old Windsor Road and Hector Court	3 x Saturdays

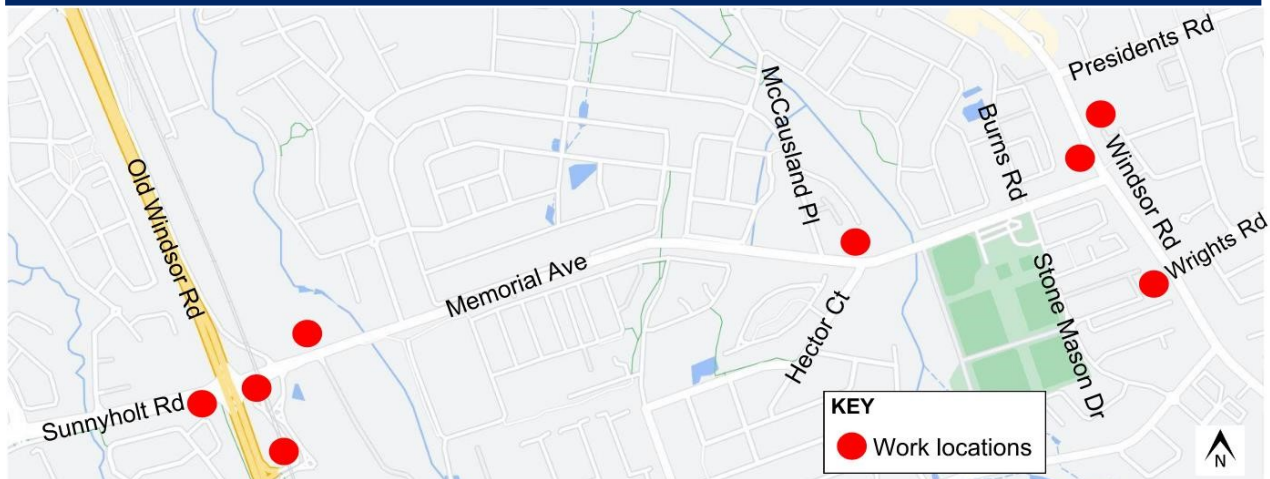
Note: 2 x 5 nights means five consecutive nights of work on two occasions during the month.

Normal construction hours are between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and between 8am and 1pm on Saturday. Our out-of-hours work in April will be between **8pm to 5am Sunday to Friday and 7am to 5pm on Saturday**. We will also be working continuously from **5am on Saturday 15 April to 5am Monday 17 April** to implement traffic changes on Memorial Avenue.

How will the work affect you?

We will be completing our work at night and on the weekends to reduce traffic disruption and any safety risks to the workers and road users. The night work will involve some use of noisy machinery. We will make every effort to lessen the disturbance where possible, completing noisier work earlier in the evening and turning off vehicles when not in use.

There will be some temporary traffic changes to make the work zone safe and during implementation of the changes to the road alignment. We will keep you updated about these disruptions with variable message boards and signage. Please keep to speed limits and follow the direction of traffic controllers and signs.
