Road resheeting and concrete works on Day and Doncaster Avenue June 2023

Concrete and road resheeting work on Day Avenue

Starting from the night of **Tuesday 13 June**, we will be working up to 30 shifts to demolish and pour concrete kerbs and islands on Day Avenue, and resurface the road, between Doncaster Avenue and Houston Road. This work will involve up to 15 nights of work.

Residents will continue to be notified of out of hours work via letterbox notification at least seven days in advance.

Road resheeting work on Doncaster Avenue

We will be working up to 10 shifts to seal and resheet the road on Doncaster Avenue between Anzac Parade and Day Avenue. This work will be completed during the day.

We will be in touch with you prior to the works to explain any impacts to driveway access.

Following this work, we will start general landscaping works between Anzac Parade and Day Avenue.

The map overleaf shows the works area on Day and Doncaster Avenue.

Work hours

Our standard hours are **7am** to **6pm Monday to Friday.**

Our out of hours work is **between 7pm** and **5am**. We may work up to **five shifts a week** and will provide a **two night break** each week.

We will let you know in advance the nights we are working.

Work is dependent on weather and site conditions and is subject to change.

Minimising community impact

Our work activities will require the use of machinery that generates noise, light, and vibration.

Equipment used for these activities include sawcutter, excavator, concrete truck, compaction equipment, vacuum truck, asphalting machines, mobile lighting towers, trucks, and excavators.

To minimise the impact of this work we will:

- complete noisiest activities such as sawcutting and jackhammering by midnight
- turn off machinery when not in use
- use noise blankets to minimise noise, where feasible
- direct temporary lighting down and away from houses

Traffic and pedestrian changes

There will be traffic changes and detours in place during our work to ensure the work zone is safe which may affect travel times.

There may be partial footpath closures near our work area and alternative path and signs will be in place.

There will be some parking impacts for a few days at a time. Access to properties will be maintained for local residents and businesses.

Please keep to speed limits and follow signs and traffic controller directions.
